- A. Pastor's Report (Fr. John)
 - (1) A special thank you was extended to specific parishioners who have contributed a significant effort over the past year to parish.
 - (2) Highlights for 2013
 - (a) Beautification goals have been met.
 - (b) The choir continued to improve.
 - (c) There was increase in the number of parishioners over the past year.
 - (d) Combined annual income exceeded \$100,000 for the first time.
 - (e) Raised over \$17,000 for the building fund.
 - (f) Raised more than \$1,000 for the St. Nicholas Children's Fund.
 - (g) The lenten retreat was well attended.
 - (h) Conducted first funeral since Fr. John arrived at the parish.
 - (i) In spite of several interruptions, completed a successful church school program.
 - (j) Unsuccessful in finding a new church facility.
 - (3) Quest for New Facility
 - (a) Discussed the pros and cons for both renting an existing structure and building a new facility.
 - (b) Diocese of South will provide financial assistance for the "right" property purchase.
 - (i) The Diocese would contribute up to \$1M for the purchase.
 - (ii) The parish would be required to pay back the loan but the terms would be much more favorable than a traditional loan from a financial institution. (Loan repayment would be based on monthly income of the parish.)
 - (c) Feedback from the parish was that either renting or purchasing would be acceptable.
